



# I've registered...now what?

#### When do the coaches get their teams?

Registration will close on 8/20 and teams will be built at that time. Coaches will receive their roster that following week. You will also get a system notification telling you which team your player is on.

# When will I find out which team my child is on?

Expect to hear from your Coach between no later than 8/31. They will give you all the information you will need in regards to practice times and location. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time and location. The practice and game fields are located throughout the Ada/Cascade area. If you have not heard from your Coach by 9/2, please let us know.

#### What does my child need?

The registration fee includes: complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks) supplemental accident insurance, a team photo and a medal. In addition, you may need to obtain shoes, shin guards, a



soccer ball (6U & 8U: size 3, 10U & 12U: size 4, 14U: size 5) and a water bottle.

### When does the season begin and end?

Practices (07U and up) can begin once school resumes after Labor Day, on 9/6. Our first games of the season will be on 9/10. We will play an 8-week season with no breaks. Last game will be on 10/29. Note: game schedules will be published at least a week in advance of the first game.

# How often are practices and games?

Players in our Playground division will have the option to meet during a weeknight or on Saturday mornings. Teams in our 5U and 6U divisions will practice AND play a game in 1 hour on Saturday mornings. Teams in our 7U, 8U and 10 divisions practice for an hour once each week and play their games on Saturday mornings. 12U and 14U teams typically practice twice weekly then play games on Saturdays with about half of their games requiring some travel, usually to a neighboring region <1 hr away.

### What if my plans change? Can I get a refund?

We get it – life happens and things change. Players withdrawing prior to 8/20 will be issued a full refund less a \$20 AYSO National processing fee. Please contact <a href="mailto:ayso571registrar@gmail.com">ayso571registrar@gmail.com</a> if you would like to request a refund.
